## FUNDED PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

Among the fundamental requirements by the Pontifical Mission Societies in the selection of projects for funding is the Project Manager's commitment to ensure safe working conditions in a healthy environment and to develop equitable relationships, fairness and respect of the workers and suppliers engaged in the construction work.

The principles guiding the conduct to be followed by anybody engaged in the performance of funded projects must be consistent with the principles of the Pontifical Mission of non-discrimination on the grounds of nationality, religion, race, sexual identity, political opinions, personal and social conditions; respect for human dignity, morality and ethics; respect of vulnerable groups, women, the best interest of children under 18, people with disabilities; equal opportunities and respect for private and family life, honour and reputation of all the participants, particularly of vulnerable groups.

Any form of infringement or misconduct that offends the above principles will not be tolerated by the Pontifical Mission Societies, which will not hesitate to defer violations to the competent authorities and to suspend or cancel awarded funding, if deemed necessary.
